2. A key feature of the school timetable is one day each week dedicated to learning outside of the classroom with the teaching team. Each term, activities will change, offering students a wide range of learning experiences in varied and stimulating environments.
3. At Park House Prep, while most students follow a full-time timetable, we recognise the importance of flexibility. This enables us to offer a personalised learning experience tailored to each student's unique needs and interests. Whether they are gifted individuals pursuing equestrian specialties, child actors honing their craft, or students benefiting from a blended learning week between school and home, we are committed to supporting our young pupils with optimal learning plans.
4. Each of the 10 numbered lessons per day lasts 30 minutes, totaling 5 hours of learning time per day.
